










Example #1 Optimizing SAT Test Center Staffing Levels

- An algorithm used to staff
 SAT test centers
 - yields the lowest staff cost per administration
 - satisfies all security requirements
 - saves \$800K/year
 - saved more than \$10 million so far





Example #2 Reducing A Reject Rate

- Reduced the reject rate in an important processing operation from an average of 60-70% to less than 10%
- Primarily a matter of educating the applicants and giving them the proper tools
- Savings of \$250K/year





Example #3 Scrubbing A "Dirty" Database


- A database conversion
 - VAX to Oracle
 - Problem: "dirty" flat files
 - IS&T estimate = 360K
 - Alternative: a PC-based "scrub" of the database
 - Program direction accepted
 - The savings => \$300K
 - The client was very happy





Example #4 Fitting 20 Pounds into a16-Pound Sack


- Collapsed 20,000 square feet of assigned space into 16,000 square feet
 - improved the productivity of the 16,000 square foot space by 25%
 - reduced space charges by \$160K per year at a onetime cost of \$16K
 - introduced an innovative paper filing, storage and retrieval technology





Example #5 A Variable Life Insurance System (NYC)


- The client had been promised a new product
- The IT mainframe shop said
 - 18 months
 - \$2 million
- It was up and running "live" on a PC/LAN in 89 days for \$250K
- The client was very happy




